2026 Visual Arts Scholarship Application

Scholarship Award and Eligibility:

The VASBCS will award a one-time, \$1000 college scholarship to each of 3 (three) seniors who will graduate by August 2026 from a high school located in Bryan/College Station. Applicants must plan a course of study and a career related to a segment of the **Visual Arts** as described below.

Our scholarships support painting, mixed media, sculpture, studio fine crafts (glass blowing, stained glass, printmaking, pottery, porcelain, woodwork, jewelry, mosaic, weaving, fiber art, metal work, or other finely crafted items), drawing (pastels, pencil, pen & ink etc.), photography, digital art and AI-mediated art. Submissions of AI-mediated art must be original and not plagiarized from existing AI-generated models, datasets, or other artists' work. Artists using AI should provide a brief description of their creative process, including how the AI was utilized to produce the final piece. Our scholarships are not for film, architecture, fashion or dance.

Scholarship payment is mailed to the recipient after proof of tuition/fee payment is submitted to the Visual Art Society B/CS (VAS) President, president@visualartsociety.org.
